## Instructions for measuring and entering "Flatfish" into the NCBA "All Time Record List" and the

#### "Annual Awards Contest"

All measurements must be made with a 1/4" flexible steel tape to the nearest one-eight of an inch.

- 1. Lay Flatfish on back on top of measuring tape. Straighten and Extend. DO NOT STRETCH.
- 2. Take measurements on flat surface from tip of nose to tip of tail and "Tip-to-Tip" of Wingspan.
- 3. When measuring greatest length "A" (nose to tail), tail must be laid straight

#### **NCBA Rules**

- 1. A witness to the weigh-in must sign the score sheet.
- 2. The hunter must possess a valid fishing license. The license number must be recorded on the score sheet.
- 3. A photo of the fish and hunter should be submitted with the scoresheet if possible.
- 4. NCBA members must turn in score sheets by the announced cutoff date (Usually January to qualify for the NCBA Annual Award Contest). There is no cutoff date for the All Time Records Listing. Hunters are not Required to be NCBA members at time of harvest to submit fish.
- 5. The official score and placement in the All Time Records shall be determined by the total weight of the fish in pounds and ounces. The heaviest entry shall be listed in the highest position.
- 6. In the event of a tie in weight, the winner shall be determined first by the greater length (Measurement A). In the event of a tie in length, the winner shall be determined by the wingspan (measurement B) of the flatfish. If the weight, length, and wingspan are exactly the same, then the fish will be declared a tie.
- 7. Any fish taken from a river, stream, lake or other impoundment which has an abnormally low water level due to drought or drainage, whether natural or man made, shall be disqualified from any record or contest.
- 8. Compound bows with more than 65% actual let off are permitted, but must be declared. Crossbows or the use of any attachments which holds the bow at partial or full draw without the use of human muscle power are prohibited.
- 9. Any other method considered by the NCBA Record System as unsportsmanlike may disqualify a potential entry.
